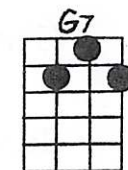
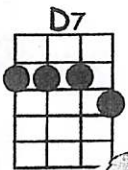
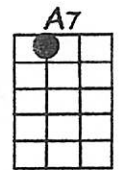
<sup>F</sup> I saw the <sup>C7</sup> Methodist sister, turn around began to <sup>F</sup> grin.
