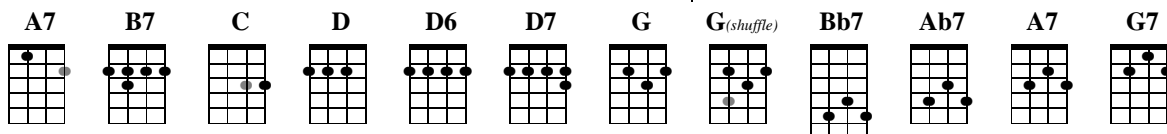


# Bad Bad Leroy Brown
