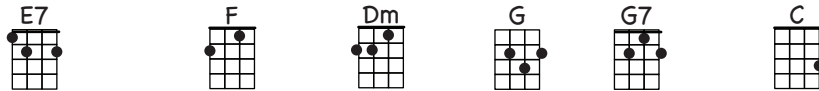
Say, it's only a paper moon, Sailing over a cardboard sea

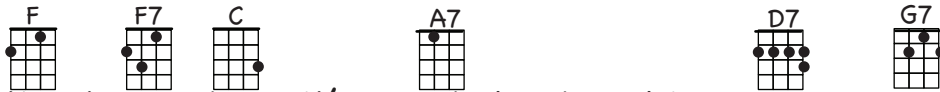
Yes, it's only a canvas sky, Hanging over a muslin tree



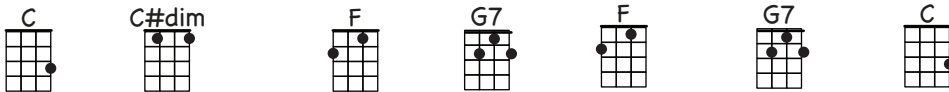

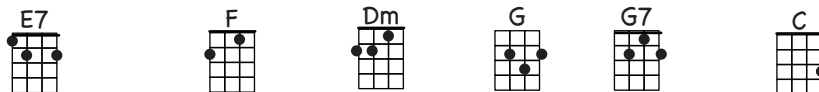
Without your love, it's a honky tonk parade
